



## Dream Day on Cape Cod's Cape and Islands Week Program

Dream Day on Cape Cod brings respite and support to medically fragile children AND their families through recreational activities. Nestled deep in the woods of Brewster, Massachusetts is Dream Day's special family camp. More than 31 acres of rolling terrain, winding trails, and shady solitude provide the optimal getaway setting for families.

The central focus of Dream Day is *family, fun, support, and respite*. Our goal is truly to support the family unit – outside of hospitals and doctor's offices – and give them the chance to create loving lasting family memories.

Our traditional overnight camp program runs for seven weeks, and an eighth week is offered specifically for Cape and Islands families. **All our programs are offered at no charge.**

In 2022, we have adapted the **Cape and Islands week** to offer more flexibility for families. Families may come for day sessions and can opt to overnight! Families are strongly encouraged to come for multiple days to get the most out of our fun programming and to connect with other Cape and Islands families. During the day, we offer a full day schedule of traditional types of camp activities like arts & crafts, swimming, fishing and boating, and campfires. Lunch is included in the day sessions (breakfast and dinner for those staying overnight).

**Dates: July 17, 18, 19, and 20 Time: Day Program - 9:30 am - 4:00 pm**

Overnights: Should you choose, your family can stay overnight in one of our 8 cabins. Our cabins are modest and rustic and include 2 rooms. One has two bunk beds (sleeps 4) and a bedroom with a queen bed. There is electricity, window fans, a microwave, and a small dorm size fridge.

Eligibility:

- Our programs are family focused. Therefore, we encourage the whole immediate family to attend if possible. (A Parent and/or legal guardian must attend.)
- To be eligible for acceptance into Dream Day, a child [age 18 & under] must have a serious illness or a severe chronic **medical** condition that significantly affects their day-to-day existence.
